Founded in 2004, Enviva is a leading global energy company specializing in sustainable wood bioenergy. We are the world's largest producer of wood pellets, a renewable and sustainable energy source used to generate electricity and heat.





Enviva has invested more than \$500 million in North Carolina and supports more than 1,500 direct and indirect jobs.



In 2017, Enviva paid more than \$20 million in annual payroll, contributed nearly \$3.5 million in tax revenue, and generated nearly \$500 million in economic activity in North Carolina.




Since 2016, the Enviva Forest Conservation Fund has invested \$770,000 in conservation projects protecting approximately 12,000 acres of sensitive forests in North Carolina.



Enviva sources wood from more than 1,000 private landowners. We provide an additional market for their low-grade wood— increasing the profitability of timber harvest activities and creating an incentive to keep forests as forests.





ENVIVA POWERS ECONOMIC GROWTH AND INVESTMENT

Enviva's North Carolina operations directly employ approximately workers. Independent economic analysis indicates that for every one job created at an Enviva facility, more than two additional domestic jobs are created in the community. Therefore, our current operations in North Carolina support approximately 1000 indirect jobs.

Enviva's new facility in Hamlet:

- Employs at least 80 full-time employees.
- Creates and supports an estimated 180 additional jobs including logging, transportation, and local services.
- Increases North Carolina loggers' sales by an estimated \$23 million.

ENVIVA IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE FOREST LANDSCAPE

North Carolina is home to more than 18 million acres of forestland. Between 2013 and 2016, forest area in the state grew by 197,300 acres. This increase is directly attributed to the stewardship of private forestland owners who own 85 percent of the state's forests. Biomass plays a small but important role in Southeastern U.S. forest markets. In 2016, biomass comprised only 4 percent of all timber products in the state.
