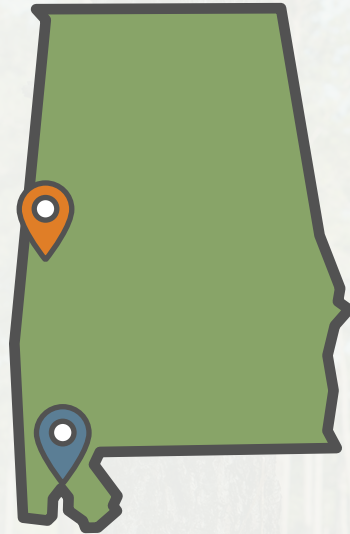
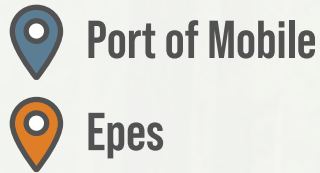

Enviva's Economic Impact in Alabama



We anticipate supporting nearly **400 jobs** across Alabama.



Our **average compensation** will be **approximately 47% higher** in the counties where we operate.



Enviva's total economic impact in Alabama (the ripple effect of Enviva's investments and operational expenses) is forecasted to be more than **\$265 million** annually.



We plan to invest approximately **\$200 million** in Alabama.



Since 1953, **wood inventory** growing in Alabama's working forests has **increased by 165%**.



We have committed to **net-zero operations by 2030**.

Across the U.S. Southeast, Enviva is on track to create and/or support an estimated 4,200 jobs and create nearly \$3 billion in annual economic impact.
