# Enviva's Economic Impact in Georgia

We support more than **400 jobs** across Georgia.



Our **average compensation** is **approximately 75% higher** in the counties where we operate.



Enviva's total economic impact in Georgia (the ripple effect of Enviva's investments and operational expenses) is forecasted to be more than **\$300 million annually**.



We have invested **\$175 million** in Georgia.



Since 1953, **wood inventory** growing in Georgia's working forests has **increased by 88%**.



We have committed to **net-zero operations by 2030**.
