We operate **nine wood pellet plants** across the U.S. Southeast.




We ship from **five deep-water export terminals** across the U.S. Southeast.

Enviva's Economic Impact in North Carolina



Enviva's total economic impact in North Carolina (the ripple effect of Enviva's investments and operational expenses) is forecasted to be close to \$1 billion annually.



We have invested approximately **\$675 million** in North Carolina.



We support more than **1,800 jobs** across North Carolina.



Since 1953, **wood inventory** growing in North Carolina's working forests has **increased by 71%**.



Our **average compensation** is **approximately 50% higher** in the counties where we operate.



We have committed to **net-zero operations by 2030**.

Across the U.S. Southeast, Enviva is on track to create and/or support an estimated 4,200 jobs and create nearly \$3 billion in annual economic impact.
